

Here is a “suggested” Supply list for your grade level.

At Back to School Night, (August 20th, from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.)
You will be given more a more specific list for your classroom.

Kindergarten- you will receive your list at Kindergarten Round-Up on August 14th, from 2:00 to 3:00.

1st Grade: First grade was sent home with all kindergarten students at the end of the 08-09 year.

2nd Grade:

Water Bottles: Due to our hot summer weather, students may bring a **pop-up top** water bottle (sports bottle) to school to have in class.

Supplies: Please send the following items to school with your child **ON THE FIRST DAY**. Your child should have a **large backpack** and **lunch bag**, clearly marked with his/her name. The following items will be shared by the class, so they **do not** need your child's name on them:

- 1 package #2 pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga or Oriole only, please)
- 6 glue sticks
- 3 dry erase markers (Expo brand only, please)
- 1 package washable markers
- 1 boxes of 12 colored pencils

The following items are for your child and should be clearly **marked with your child's name**:

- 1 box of 16 crayons
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 pair children's scissors
- 1 “**Spacemaker**” type pencil box (5 x 8- 1/2”, plastic and easy-to-clean; please write name on the inside lid with a permanent marker)

Optional, but much appreciated:

Printer cartridges (HP DeskJet 6127 color cartridge #78 and black #45), more glue sticks, more colored pencils, Ziplock “freezer” gallon bags and sandwich bags, black Sharpie markers, post-it type notes, water color paint sets, **COPIER PAPER** (white or pastels).

3rd Grade:

Items that will contribute to your child's success this year

- One backpack
- 1 pencil box (5x8 1/2" plastic and easy to clean)
- One 1" white binder with plastic cover sleeve
- 1 spiral bound 8 1/2"x11" notebook with your child's name on it
- Colored pencils (box of 12 to 24, presharpener)
- One box of Crayola markers thick tip
- 6 glue sticks (Elmer's or UHU brand preferably)
- 5 dry erase markers (Expo brand only please)
- An old sock or dry erase eraser
- 3 highlighter pens (yellow, pink, and green only, please)
- 1 individual pencil sharpener with a shavings catch

Optional, but much appreciated:

Binder paper, Clorox Wipes, Anti-Bacterial Gel, "Freezer" zip-lock gallon and sandwich bags

4th and 5th Grade:

Please label all supplies! Please do not bring a binder or "Trapper Keeper"; it won't fit in your desk!
