Oak Meadow Elementary is **located** in the fabulous community of El Dorado Hills, CA. We first opened its doors in 2002. We currently serve more than 800 students on a modified traditional schedule running from mid August through early June. Oak Meadow's school colors are burgundy, gold and navy blue, with our mascot being, the raptors.

We believe we have much to offer our students and community. In 2007, Oak Meadow was selected as an [Honor Roll School](#) for its exemplary progress in **closing the achievement gap**. Our student-run "Team Raptors" Conflict Resolution Program and Positive Action Program helps keeps **our school safe** and promotes security and pride at our school. We place a **high value on student use of technology**. Students use computers in the classroom, in our computer lab, and in the library. Students are introduced to Microsoft Office early in their education, and often make use of such programs as PowerPoint, Word, and Excel in their school work. Students' horizons expand through frequent and effective internet and electronic research and learning opportunities. In addition, Oak Meadow students participate in the Accelerated Reading Program, Renzulli Learning, Math Symphony, Lexia Phonics and Reading and Mavis Beacon.

Oak Meadow holds consistently **high academic standards for all students**. In every year of the state's Academic Performance Index (API) program, Oak Meadow has achieved a growth score over 800, placing it in the category of "**high achieving school**" status every year. Oak Meadow offers a variety of services to meet the needs of all learners, including Gifted and Talented Education, Class Size Reduction in grades K-3, Resource Specialist Program, Special Day Class, Speech and Language, During/After School Intervention Program, Student Study Team, and English Learner Program. These programs, combined with a strong school-wide academic focus, research-based curriculum, and dedicated staff, ensure that all Oak Meadow students achieve the skills necessary for success in school and in life. Oak Meadow students also have opportunities for growth and development beyond the classroom. Many students participate in Oak Meadow's Choir, Band, Spring Play Production, Student Leadership, Cross Country, Odyssey of the Mind and PC Pals. Oak Meadow parents get in on the fun as well, with Site Council, Meet the Masters Art Docent Program, Oak Meadow Foundation, many parents volunteers, and an active PTA. As you can see there are many ways to be involved.
